

### Strains

1. Police Officer was jumping a fence in foot pursuit of a burglary suspect and twisted his left knee.
2. Police Officer was moving boxes and going through files over a 10 week period which caused injury to both hands and wrists.
3. Police Officer received an injury to his right foot when he jumped down from an ambulance which was transporting a prisoner.

### Cuts

1. As Police Officer was cleaning a rifle, the bottom part of the stock broke off hitting right index finger.
2. Police Officer was using a drill to fix an item when the drill bit broke and went through left thumb.

### Resulting from Vehicle Accidents

1. Police Officer received a small laceration to right side of forehead.

### Falls

1. Police Officer was exiting vehicle when his feet got tangled up which resulted him falling to the ground injuring his face.

### Exposures

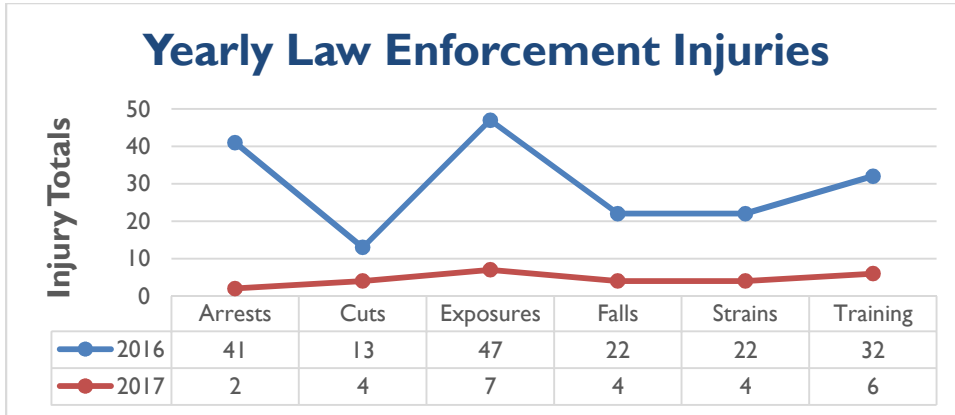
1. (2) Police Officers were exposed to suspect who had TB.
2. Police Officer inhaled strong fumes from the evidence locker resulting in coughing, tingling to face and body and numbness to his lips.
3. Police Officer was separating narcotics and was exposed to a fentanyl patch.
4. Police Officer was bitten by a K-9 in left calf while knocking on a residence door.

### Arrests

1. While executing a search warrant, Police Officer injured his right wrist while struggling with suspect.

### Training

1. While participating in defensive tactics handcuff training at the academy, Police Officer was thrown to the ground injuring his left knee.
2. While participating in training at the academy, Police Officer suffered from a sinus infection and bronchitis.
3. During defensive tactics training, Police Officer was knocked to the ground and injured the back of his head.



Although there is no 100% protection for Law Enforcement officers, officers who wear ballistic vests and utilize seat belts when operating their vehicles have a greater chance of survival than those who choose otherwise.
